Hoover Sailing Club is a volunteer club that promotes the sport of sailing, with an emphasis on One-Design class boats. There are five types of membership open to new members:

- Active membership - the applicant must own or acquire a boat belonging to one of the club's nine active fleets.
- Young Adult – similar to active membership (must own a fleet boat) with most of the privileges and responsibilities, but discounted for persons age 19 to 28.
- Extended Visitation - a one-year membership renewable on a space-available basis for people who own a one-design open-cockpit monohull boat less than 21 feet long.
- Associate - a temporary membership, renewable for two years, to enable the applicant to become familiar with the club. Associate members enjoy many of the privileges and obligations of full membership, but may not launch or store a boat on club grounds.
- Junior Sailing - Family has at least one child age 7 to 19 who has committed to sail as part of the HSC junior sailing team, or is a member of another club's junior sailing team and wants to practice with HSC's team.

All questions must be answered in full and an **application fee of \$21.35** (this includes a 6.75% tax) must be paid for the application to be considered. **Please print.**
